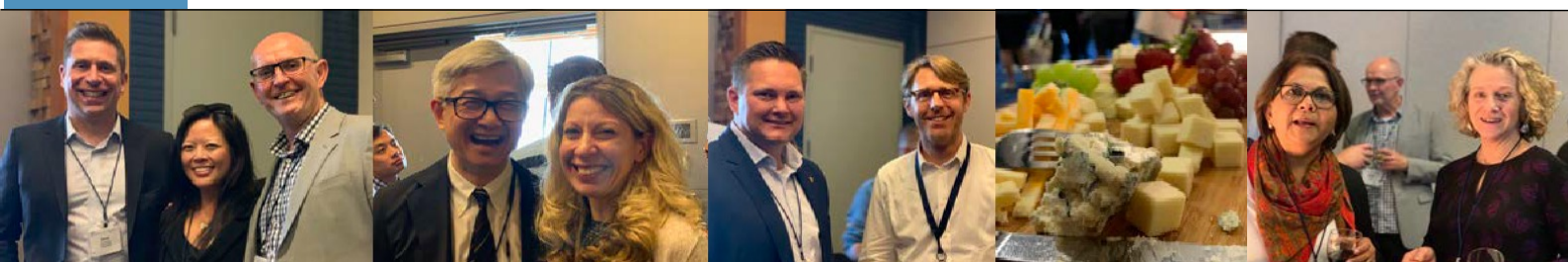
Please mark your calendars for our 100th IADR meeting that takes place in **Chengdu, China from June 20 to 25, 2022**.

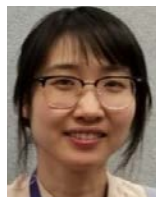
