

AADOCR Meeting Within a Meeting: Aging and Oral Health Research

As part of the AADOCR science-first initiative to bring new opportunities for membership, professional development, and program growth, AADOCR presented its second Meeting within a Meeting (MwM) featuring cutting-edge presentations on the biology and social aspects of aging, and how aging affects health and disease.

The first session gave delegates a broad overview of current geroscience research about the biologic mechanisms of aging and how they impact oral diseases. The second session provided a holistic overview of the social and behavioral aspects of aging, including nutrition and cognitive decline, and the relationships with oral disease. The third and final session focused on research and training needed to improve the delivery of oral health care for aging populations.
