## **Speakers**

**Keynote Speaker: Prof. David Herrera**; Professor and Chair of Periodontology at the Faculty of Odontology, Complutense University of Madrid (UCM), Spain.

Prof. Herrera is a world-renowned periodontist with several landmark research papers that have had important clinical implications to dental practice. His research focusses primarily on the *Etiology and Therapy of Periodontal and Peri-implant Diseases*. He is currently the Workshop Committee Chair of the European Federation of Periodontology (EFP) and Co-Director of the Graduate Program in Periodontology at UCM. He has also served as President of the Spanish Society of Periodontology, the European Division of the IADR, and the Periodontal Research Group of the IADR. Prof. Herrera has published over 210 scientific journal papers that are highly cited and has a Scopus *h*-index of 60.
